- Coach is working on an Alumni Flag Football Game in conjunction with our Annual Dinner Auction, still working on details. Possible date of August 21st. everyone loved the idea.
- Also wants to try and have a Homecoming Parade on Sept 25th. We play Mtn View that night; coach is talking to the band & cheerleaders. We used to do these and really wants to get back to doing them.
- He also is working on trying to schedule a Middle School Football Game at MHS to help with some of the gate sales; something about if the player/parent comes to the game they get a discount into one of our games. Talking with the AD about this. He has tried many times and always gets "shut down" but thinks he may get his wish this year.
- March 5th is the date set for meeting with the Middle School football kids at MMS it's the annual open house but it includes all the sports, wants to try and set up a meeting with just football players, and the booster will go and talk to them also and maybe sell some apparel.
- Coach is also going to talk with Tony Bradford about having some Optimist team play during half time of the Lewiston game, they did this in Lake City and the crowd loved it, will be a good way for us to help with low gates sales the night of the Lewiston game, he will let us know what he finds out.

Treasures Report:

- Mike said the balance in our account right now is \$2322.00
- We received a ck for \$150.00 for the freshman helping with parking during dairy days, will put into the "general account" if no freshman parents needs repayment for the end of the year banquet, if they do they need to request it from him directly up to the \$150.00 we have from the check.
- We will have a new form this year for asking for reimbursement for any items you purchased. All forms must be signed off by the person requesting the money & the committee chairperson in charge of that fundraiser. Without that no check will be cut. By using this new form this will insure that each fundraiser does not go over budget and all purchases must be approved. This will help with anyone spending money that was not approved because it's the chairperson's job to keep everyone within the budget.

Grill/Concessions:
